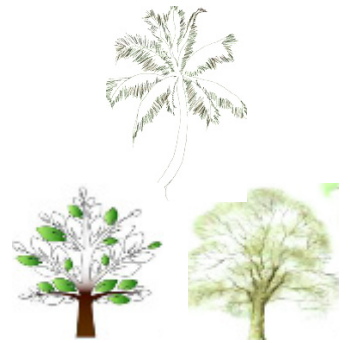

District 1130 Tree Planting – to Promote Peace and Celebrate Rotary and the Commonwealth

Tree Planting at King George Park V – Newham, Saturday 24th March 2018 @ 11am

The tree planting project was co-ordinated by The Commonwealth Rotarian Peace Envoys and themed : Rotary and the Commonwealth Promoting Peace. This is part of the Commonwealth celebrations that began on Commonwealth Day on 12th March and ends of 20th April 2018 – which marks the end of the events pertaining to the Commonwealth Heads of Government Meeting (CHOGM) in London.

The Commonwealth Rotarian Peace Envoys purchased 210 trees from the Woodlands Trust and planting was completed on 24th March. District Governor Mike Hodge, DGN Tony Sharma and Assistant Governor Himanshu Jain led an enthusiastic team of Rotarians to complete the planting with the able assistance of Newham Council staff. Over 30 Rotarians from London Clubs including Tower Hamlets, Newham, Stratford, Barnet, Pall Mall and Westminster West turned up to assist. Newham Council will maintain these trees.
